
Navigators



Pastor Mat's Musings

Over the last month we have been dreaming for our church and our community. I want to spend some time talking about what was posted on our dream board over the last month and where we go from here. Although we had more than 3 dreams posted, I found that our dreams were easily divided into three categories: church modernization, church systems, and continued growth of existing as well as new ministry programming.

Modernization consisted of by far the most dreams placed on the board. The dreams vastly ranged in scope from adding projectors and utilizing more modern music all the way to maintaining a more comfortable temperature during worship. The heart behind these dreams is clear. We all share a common desire to look forward to our church experience. When we are honest with ourselves we admit that in some ways our church experience has not created an atmosphere that people always want to be at . This isn't to say our church experience is "wrong" or "bad." This is more to say that our church experience needs to evolve. This evolution is not just for our own members but for our entire community.

Church systems was another category found on the dream board. In other words, why do we do the things that we do and how can we do them better? These dreams spoke about things like easier ways to take attendance, a more relevant Facebook page, and having clearer definitions of our small groups. These dreams are very important because these dreams show that First Christian Church has a heart to get people connected.

The last category of dreams was continued growth of our current ministry groups as well as adding new opportunities. These dreams are perhaps the most important. A church is only as strong as its people's desire to grow in fellowship. These dreams exhibit our desire to grow in fellowship.

So where do we go from here? The dream board has made it clear that we have a lot of work to do. Before we get started, we need to keep three things in mind:

-Pray first because God brings the growth. 1st Corinthians 3:7 "7 So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow." We can modernize the entire church. We can have the most efficient systems. We can have the best small groups. None of it will matter without God at the center. God is the grower of faiths. God is the grower of small groups. God is the best tech guy you know. This is why it is crucially important that the elders, myself, and you all pray this month over these dreams. Pray that God gives us clarity on where God wants us to modernize, where God wants us to change our systems, and where God wants us to add more ministry programming.

-It is going to take time. Some of these dreams will be fulfilled quicker than others. This Sunday, for example, will have some changes. Some dreams though will require more time and patience waiting on God's direction. Be patient with God. As we have seen in our recent sermons, God does not always reveal his promises immediately. Stay steadfast. Enjoy this time of prayer and patience.

-These dreams will require sacrifice. Christ is the ultimate example of this. To fulfill God's dream of being close to humanity there had to be a sacrifice. Likewise, many of the dreams we have as a congregation will require sacrifice. I wish I had a list of what those sacrifices will be, but I don't. I do know that our comfort zone will be stretched. There will be times where you will absolutely dislike new changes. You will disagree with decisions, and sometimes you may even be hurt by the decisions. In those times lean on God. Have faith that God has First Christian Church in his hands.

I hope that all of you are excited about the future of First Christian Church. I know that I am! God's will for this place is good no matter the outcome. Because of that we can have peace. So pray with me this month. Pray for God to give us guidance so we can be a beacon of hope to Gibson City.


Upcoming Sermons
