Pastor Mat's Musing May 2021

Our garage looks like the Tasmanian devil lives there. Moving only a mile still requires boxes, trash, and ridding oneself of old belongings. I am a "garage guy." My personal space is the garage. But, for now... the garage is rubble and chaos. Not a great place for one's "personal space." Every change, every remake, creates rubble. Right now, the entire Christian world is in the middle of that "remake."

The pandemic has stopped business as usual. Family life, work life, church life, social life have all been impacted. It really has caused a reboot, and a relook at what we were doing prepandemic compared with how we should do it post. There will be changes for all aspects of our lives. Essential in this season is the willingness to be listeners to God's Spirit. One of the values as Christians is "to keep in step with the spirit." What an awesome time for us to do that! We are listening to the Spirit, and leaning back on our values and calling.
