# From the Pastor

Things are important. Well, sure, not everything, and some things are more important to us than others. Some things are very important; we rely and depend upon these things. And because we so rely on these things, we care about them; they receive our attention and our care.

People are important to us, too. We count and rely upon other people. Sure, we count on some people more than we do others, but we do count on many people, even strangers. And we care about these other people in varying degrees. Especially do we care about those people most important to us and not just because we count on them, not just because of what they do for us. We love these people.

All of this is pretty obvious, I guess, but I write about these things to show you how important faith is to us. We need to have a certain amount of faith in things, to trust in them. Just the same we must be able to have faith in other people. We must be able to trust them, to trust that they will be faithful to us, will keep faith with us. We need to trust others; it is essential. Just the same, these other people are counting on us, upon our trustworthiness, our faithfulness, our keeping faith with them. These other people have faith, too. They are counting and relying upon us. They need to trust us.

I write about this faith—I guess you could call it our natural faith—because it feels to me that, in these days, it is being eroded. There seems to me to be less and less trust and trustworthiness between people these days. It worries me. It worries me a great deal. This faith is essential. Can't live without it, at least not very well.

What to do? Because I can't save the world—and I doubt any of you can, either—I try to do the good thing that is front of me, no matter how small and insignificant it may be. No matter how small and insignificant it is, what I am able to do still matters. It matters to God. Sure it does. I am important to God, even though there is nothing I can do for God that God cannot do without my help. I belong to God. God cares about me and even loves me. So I try to be loyal to God, to be faithful to this One faithful to me. But not only do I belong to God, but so do you and so does anyone else I happen to meet. God is faithful to you and to these. God loves you and these. You and these others are important to God. And what better way for me to keep faith with God, to be faithful to God, is there than my keeping faith and being faithful to you and to these others? So I try to be trustworthy to all whom I meet, even in small things. Even in small ways, I try to love and care for my neighbors, these whom God loves and for whom God cares.

A small thing, I guess. But small things add up. Maybe my small things and your small things will add up to something.
