#### More in the Life and Witness of the First Christian Church

#### From the Pastor

The news on Easter morning is that God has done what we could not, could never. God has raised Jesus Christ from the dead, from sin and death. And God will raise us, too, from sin and death. That's the news. That's the good news. That is the gospel, the gospel of Jesus Christ. God has done what we could not. And God will do what we could never.

The good news—the gospel—is about what God does, not about what we do. This is why you won't hear me telling you from the pulpit what you had better do, what you had better do and believe or else. I will talk with you about what we can now do and that we can now believe because of what God has done and is doing in Jesus Christ. But I will not tell you from the pulpit what you had better or what you ought. That isn't my job. My job is to tell you what God has done, what God is now doing, and what God will do. That is what the gospel is about and my job is to preach the gospel, to preach the good news of Jesus Christ.

The good news is about what God does. It is not about what we ought and had better. And this is why the Apostle Paul was just beside himself when he wrote his Letter to the Galatians. He just couldn't believe what those Galatians were doing. Those Galatians were thinking that they had better do something; they had better start living according to the Law, had better start living right, had better start obeying the Law. They were starting to think that it was all up to them and they ought to straighten themselves out and had better start living right. They were starting to think that it was all up to them and that everything depended upon what they did.

But the good news is that God does something. It isn't all up to us and it all doesn't depend upon what we do. God is with us, the One who raised Jesus Christ from the dead, from sin and death. God does for us what we cannot and could never. God raises us up with Christ. God raises us up from sin and death. We are not alone. God, who raised Jesus Christ, is with us as individuals and is with us as a church.

And now we can believe, can believe again. And we can have hope. And all kinds of things are now possible. We can do all kinds of things. Thanks be to God, who raised Jesus Christ from sin and death.
