More in the Life and Witness of the First Christian Church

A PASTOR'S PONDERING

The Gibson Area Music Foundation has tapped me to direct this year's Hymn Festival, to happen at the end of this month, on Sunday the 27th. I've selected for this year's theme, *When in Our Music God Is Glorified*. It's based on the hymn text by Fred Pratt Green, penned in 1971. I'd like to share that text with you here, because music is very important to me — and I think it's vitally important to the life of the church.

When in our music God is glorified, And adoration leaves no room for pride, It is as though the whole creation cried, "Alleluia!"

How often, making music, we have found A new dimension in the world of sound, As worship moved us to a more profound "Alleluia!"

So has the church, in liturgy and song, In faith and love, through centuries of wrong, Borne witness to the truth in every tongue: "Alleluia!"

And did not Jesus sing a Psalm that night When utmost evil strove against the light? Then let us sing, for whom he won the fight: "Alleluia!"

Let every instrument be tuned for praise! Let all rejoice who have a voice to raise! And may God give us faith to sing always: "Alleluia!"

The very first anointed-believers — Jesus' disciples — sang a Psalm following the very first communion service. God's faithful have always sung together; the book of Psalms is our earliest known hymnal. These Psalms were set to music, and were meant to be *sung*. Music is an important, integral, almost indispensable component of our worship. That's because music involves us holistically. We feel its vibrations in our bodies, we carry it's tides in our breathing. Music moves us emotionally and creates space in us for *wonder*. It can move us to a position of *reflection* and open us to creative thinking. Music in worship can help put us in touch with the spiritual atmosphere and movement within the assembled people. Music sung together adds warmth, depth, and movement to an otherwise rather two-dimensional experience.

And, music moves us *spiritually*. As we make music together, we create vibrations and put them out into the world, which is God's body. In doing so, we align ourselves with God's voice.

Worship expert and minister Thomas Long says that we should sing music that is "excellent, eclectic, and <u>congregational</u>." We need to sing together. Singing draws us together in community, helping us to become one in the body of Christ.

I hope you'll continue to lift your voices exuberantly in song — even if you don't sing very well. I hope you'll endeavor to open yourselves to learn music you haven't encountered before. And I hope you'll come and be part of this year's Hymn Festival, It will be as if the whole creation cried, "Alleluia!"


